Fall Festival plans include a Friday night exhibitor "Meet and Greet" dinner. Provided by the IEHJA Board of Directors, this event is a fun way to socialize with barn mates and meet new friends. Games, stall decorating and the hilarious "bouncy ball races" make this event a great way to kick off the horse show competition.

Other fun attractions include such classes as the Hunt Team Pairs, Costume Class and the very competitive IEHJA Showdown Perpetual Medal. As an added rider incentive, IEHJA offers a \$200 Scholarship Award open to Junior and adult amateurs and a \$200 award to the winner of the Hunter Derby.
